

6 Things You Might Not Know About Indian Shores, Florida





1. Indian Shores was once part of Indian Rocks Beach.

With Indian Rocks Beach to the north and Redington Shores to the south, Indian Shores is located right in between. But it wasn't always so independent. In 1927, the government filled the pass just north of the present day town limits, joining the upper Sand Key to the lower beaches. Incorporated in 1949 and called Indian Rocks Beach South Shore, the name was shortened to Indian Shores in 1973.



2. Indian Shores is home to a seabird sanctuary.

The Seaside Seabird Sanctuary is the largest, non-profit, wild bird hospital in the United States. It is dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation and release of sick, injured and orphaned wild birds. The Sanctuary provides a home to nonreleasable patients. See pelicans, herons, egrets, owls, hawks and other regional birds up close. Admission is free and it is open 7 days a week.



3. You have access to the best of both water worlds.

Because Indian Shores, Florida is a barrier island located just west of St. Petersburg and Tampa, it is perfectly situated between the Gulf of Mexico and the Intracoastal Waterway. Not only do you get to enjoy 2.65 miles of pristine beach, but you also get close and convenient access to both bodies of water. That translates into two times the water fun for you and your family.



4. You can play mini golf with pirates and gators!

Smugglers Cove Mini Golf is more than a putt-putt course. It's a pirate and alligator adventure, too! Along with your 18 holes, you'll navigate through caves, pirate ships, and waterfalls. Oh, and live alligators! Take it up a notch and feed the alligators, if you dare. Try your hand at the cane fishing pole technique and give those gators a tasty snack. Take your family on a golf adventure like no other!



5. Sea turtles love the beach on Indian Shores.

Indian Shores beach is home to nesting sea turtles every year. Sea turtle nesting season on Florida's Gulf Coast brings these amazing aquatic reptiles to our shoreline from May through October. They love our soft sands just as much as we do. Sea turtles are pretty awesome creatures who fight steep odds for survival. You can help them by limiting outdoor lights at night and filling in holes in the sand.



6. Indian Shores beach is not the only piece of paradise.

Town Square Nature Park in Indian Shores is a nature lover's dream. Find peaceful bliss in this local park. Walk the boardwalk, watch the egrets, and enjoy the fishing pier. There are family-friendly facilities including free parking, picnic pavilions, restrooms and observation areas. It is a hidden gem and well worth the visit. Be sure to keep an eye out for manatees and dolphins, too!

Public Boat Ramps & Docks

Park Boulevard Boat Ramp, 18651 Gulf Blvd., Indian Shores

This 6.5 acre boating facility is located on the Intracoastal Waterway. The facility is open 24 hours a day. It features 73 vehicle and boat trailer parking spaces, 6 boat launching lanes, 3 floating docks, restrooms, and night lighting.

Indian Rocks Beach Public Docks, at 3rd Ave. & 1st Street

Indian Rocks Beach has a 17-slip transient boat dock on the Intracoastal Waterway, about 200 yards south of the Walsingham Bridge. These docks provide boaters access to a wide variety of restaurants and shops in the Downtown area. Dockage is free and the Gulf of Mexico beach is only 200 yards away.

Belleair Causeway Boat Ramp, 541 S. Belleair Causeway, Belleair Bluffs

The facility offers 108 boat trailer parking spaces, 98 passenger parking spaces,

10 boat launching lanes, 5 courtesy docks, and a fishing pier. The boat ramp is open 24 hours per day. Portable restroom facilities are on site.

Pinellas County's fee schedule for boat ramp parks:

- \$6.00 per day for vehicles with trailers
- \$2.00 per day for vehicles without trailers



Public Beach Parks

Here are 2 of our local beaches where you can readily find parking for a day at the beach.

Indian Rocks Beach Park, 18th Avenue & Gulf Blvd.

Amenities include: 80 parking spaces, restrooms, outdoor showers. In addition, Indian Rocks Beach has another 26 public beach accesses each with its own unique character and style.

2. Tiki Gardens, 19601 Gulf Blvd., Indian Shores

Amenities include: 170 parking spaces, restroom facilities, benches, water fountain, outdoor showers, and a pedestrian crossing light at Gulf Boulevard.

Noteworthy Beaches of the Tampa Bay Area

Clear blue water and sugary white sand are trademarks of the Gulf Coast beaches. These beaches have their own vibe, types of people, wildlife, and sea shells. Enjoy your stay with us by doing some beach hopping at some of the best beaches in the U.S.A. Here we go from north to south along Pinellas County's shoreline.

- 1. Honeymoon Island State Park There are four miles of beach to explore along with a three-mile trail through one of the last remaining virgin slash pine forests. Look for squarish shaped rocks along the shoreline that may contain amethyst geodes. Find delicate, white baby's ear and angel wing seashells. The ferry to the next park in our list, Caladesi Island, departs from Honeymoon Island.
- 2. Caladesi Island State Park Voted No. 2 beach in the U.S.A. by Dr. Beach in 2022. Stroll along the island's pristine beaches or take a nature trail walk to the historic Scharrer Homestead through the island's interior and listen to the ocean breeze whisper through old-growth trees.
- 3. Clearwater Beach Voted the best beach in the U.S.A. in 2019, 2018, and 2016. Clearwater Beach is known for lots of activity at its beach hotels and night life. Rollerbladers glide along a winding beachfront promenade lined with restaurants and cafes. Come sunset, Pier 60 hosts a nightly festival with street performers and craft vendors.
- 4. Indian Rocks Beach Located directly between Clearwater Beach and St. Pete Beach. The island getaway is known for beautiful, uncrowded beaches. It's a laid-back, family-friendly beach with a small town vibe. Enjoy local seafood at award-winning restaurants.
- 5. Madeira Beach is best known for the sea-themed John's Pass Village and Boardwalk, which serves up shops, eateries, and boat tours along a 1100-foot boardwalk. Swim out to the sandbar and find sand dollars. Find some of the most colorful seashells on our shores.
- 6. St. Pete Beach was named TripAdvisor's No. 1 Beach in the U.S. in 2021 (and 5th in the world)! The historic pink Don CeSar Hotel built in 1928 looms over the shore. The Pass-A-Grille area offers galleries, shops and restaurants. The Gulf Beaches Historical Museum displays postcards and other artifacts in a 1917 church.
- 7. Fort DeSoto Park This much-loved county park covers five islands and 1,136 acres on the Gulf of Mexico and Tampa Bay. There is a historic fort to explore. It is a nature preserve and bird sanctuary. Snorkel to find fish, snails, sea cucumbers, octopi, and probably the biggest variety of seashells in the area.
- 8. Egmont Key Ferries depart daily to Egmont Key from Fort DeSoto Park, John's Pass, and Gulfport. You'll find a deserted fort and town. Some parts of the fort are under shallow water and make great places to snorkel.





In a churning force of wind and

rain, Hurricane Idalia plucked a most unexpected cargo from the sky - flamingos!

WHERE DID THEY COME FROM?

These bright pink birds found their migration path rudely interrupted by the storm's fury. Tossed from their intended path between Mexico and Cuba, these tropical birds found themselves deposited right here on the shores of Pinellas County, Florida. Hurricane Idalia likely carried the pink birds throughout the Eastern United States. Displaced flamingos have been spotted in Florida, Ohio, Texas, and as far north as Wisconsin.

ARE FLAMINGOS NATIVE TO FLORIDA?

Most wild flamingos disappeared from Florida around the turn of the 20th century due to overhunting for their colorful feathers and habitat loss. In the mid 1920's, people started captive colonies of flamingos in South Florida, including a breeding colony at Hialeah Park Race Track in

the 1930s, which still remains. The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) treats flamingos as a native species protected under the Federal Migratory Bird Treaty Act.2

HOW BIG ARE FLAMINGOS?

The American Flamingo is one of the largest species of flamingo in the world, averaging up to 5 feet tall thanks to long legs and an elongated neck. Average weights are between 4-8 pounds.²

HOW DO FLAMINGOS FIND FOOD?

Flamingos use their webbed feet to stir up shallow water to find food. The way they move around in the water to stir up food is called "The Flamingo Dance." They eat algae, small seeds, tiny crustaceans (like brine shrimp), fly larvae, and other plants and animals that live in shallow waters. When it's time to eat, a flamingo puts its head upside down in the water to scoop up food. Flamingos get their pink to red colored feathers, because of the pigment in their food, such as shrimp.²

WHAT HAPPENED TO PEACHES?

On September 1, 2023 a flamingo was rescued floating in the Gulf of Mexico off St. Pete Beach by boaters. The next day SPCA Tampa Bay took the bird to the Seaside Seabird Sanctuary on Indian Shores for rehabilitation.

The staff determined that the flamingo was in overall good condition, but quiet and clearly exhausted. After a day of rest and supportive care, the bird began self-feeding, and by week's end became much more active and vocal. The flamingo was affectionately named Peaches for the bright color of its feathers. The staff at the Seaside Seabird Sanctuary continued supportive care to allow Peaches to gain weight and get stronger.


WHERE WILL THE FLAMINGOS GO NEXT?

The Seaside Seabird Sanctuary collaborated with Jerry Lorenz of Audubon Florida and Frank Ridgley of Zoo Miami who started the Florida Flamingos Working Group. They fitted Peaches with a federal band, a resight band, and a satellite transmitter to track its movements. Peaches is only the second flamingo ever to be banded in the United States, and the transmitter will provide incredibly valuable data and insight into Peaches' movements for at least 2-3 years. The banding was done under appropriate federal permitting and special permission from the USGS banding lab. The bands and transmitter weigh about as much as a pen, and while they may be a little annoying for the bird at first, it will not cause pain or distress.³

With its new tracking device, Tampa Bay's "Peaches" will give scientists a lot of information about flamingos in Florida.

There are so many questions! Will the flamingos brought to our shores stay here? If they return to the Yucatan and Cuba, will they come back later? Florida once had breeding flamingos year-round. Maybe we'll see wild flamingos here again, with the protection and recovery of their habitat, such as coastal wetlands, the Everglades and Florida Bay.¹

PEACHES DOES THE FLAMINGO DANCE

When Peaches was released the bird's caregivers were treated to a show of rousing, bathing, preening, and even the quintessential "Flamingo Dance" as Peaches stirred up the sediment while foraging in the water. After about an hour, Peaches took flight! While there were no other flamingos seen at the release area, there had been daily reported sightings of a flock nearby. By the way, a flock of flamingos is called a "flamboyance," because of the bright color of their feathers. The release area in Fort DeSoto Park was chosen for its ideal habitat, foraging opportunities for food, and being a good distance away from the dangers of major roadways. Areas of Fort DeSoto Park are blocked off from humans to serve as a wild bird sanctuary.

PLEASE BE KIND

You may see wild flamingos visiting public places where there are people. There have been reports, unfortunately, involving some people harassing Peaches to get up close for photos. The biggest message Seaside Seabird Sanctuary has tried to share throughout this experience is that people need to give these birds space and respect. It's not a good idea to chase flamingos to get a selfie. It can be very dangerous for them. Please do not try to approach wild flamingos that you see. People can enjoy them by being kind and keeping a distance.3

If you want to see flamingos up close there are places in the Tampa Bay Area where you can see captive flamingos such as Busch Gardens Tampa, Sunken Gardens, and Zoo Tampa.

The presence of these hurricane-blown birds offers a reminder of the interconnectedness of the natural world. A big storm, while destructive, could also encourage unexpected encounters, forcing creatures to venture beyond their known horizons. And while the future of these pinkfeathered voyagers remains uncertain, their arrival in Pinellas County serves as a testament to the enduring beauty and adaptability of life in the face of unexpected winds.

Imagine this:

A sun-drenched island embraced by the Gulf of Mexico on one side and the Intracoastal Waterway on the other. The natural world around Indian Rocks Beach is brimming with diverse ecosystems, from saltkissed beaches to whispering pine forests. There is so much to explore and discover!

EXAMPLES OF ECOSYSTEMS

Coastal Playground

Step onto sugar white beaches where gentle waves lap against the shore and seabirds pirouette above. Hidden beneath turquoise waters, accessible by snorkel or kayak, Indian Rocks Beach is teeming with life. Dolphin pods frolic offshore, while majestic manatees graze on seagrass, their gentle presence reminding us of the ecosystem's fragility. Take your family and friends island hopping on a captained tour or rent a boat or jet skis.

Mangrove Magic

Venture into the labyrinthine world of mangrove islands, where gnarled trees with aerial roots filter brackish water, creating a haven for wading birds like ibis and egrets, their long legs navigating shallows teeming with tiny fish and crabs. Kayaking through these emerald tunnels offers a glimpse into this unique ecosystem.

Oak Hammock Enchantment

Pine flatwoods, dominated by towering pines and carpeted with saw palmetto, beckon you to hike amidst the scent of sun-warmed needles. See the flittering of colorful butterflies along the trail. Listen for the rhythmic drumming of woodpeckers and the melodic calls of songbirds like the chatty mockingbird. These sandy havens are also home to the gopher tortoise, whose burrows provide shelter for numerous other creatures.

TYPES OF TOURS

What is an ecotour?

Ecotours allow guests to immerse themselves in their surroundings while making as small a footprint as possible on the ecosystem.

Self-Guided Tours

Enjoy a stroll in a nature preserve and look for turtles and manatees in the water. Wander through a wildlife

sanctuary to see animals up close. Rent a kayak, jet ski, or boat and go exploring. Here are some places near our beaches.

Guided Tours

A guided tour is fun with a local guide who knows the area and its wildlife and takes out a small group, like a family. Formal boat tours may have 50-75 people. There is a planned route and a guide who makes a formal presentation. There may be marine animals pulled from the water that you can look at up close and touch. Some tours offer light snacks and beverages.
